This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B) from 22.2% in 2016 Year 3 Reading to 40% in 2018 Year 5 Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B from 22.2% in 2016 Year 3 Numeracy to 35% in 2018 Year 5 Numeracy.
- Continue with the implementation of Daily Rapid Reading Program across the whole school.
- Focus on Literacy and Numeracy outcomes for students in Prep to Year 2.

Our initiatives include


- Review student performance data and implement short, focused learning programs for all students who are below National Minimum Standard and in the U2B.
- Develop staff capability and improve student learning outcomes in Numeracy, U2B and STEM literacy skills through attendance at the Hervey Bay/Maryborough Numeracy and English Cluster Professional Development workshops.
- Use Early Start materials across the Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning, resourcing and track progress.

Employ additional teacher aides to deliver and implement the Daily Rapid Reading Program	\$18 000
